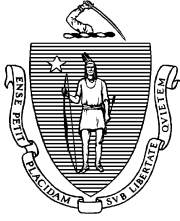


SENATE NO. 825



AN ACT RELATIVE TO EVIDENCE OF NEGLIGENCE IN MOTOR VEHICLE HOMICIDE

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 90 of the General laws, as appearing in the 2002 Official Edition, is
2 hereby amended by inserting after section 24P the following section:-

3 Section 24Q. For purposes of proving negligence in a prosecution for violation of section 24G
4 or 24L, or section 13 of chapter 265 if such violation was committed by use of a motor vehicle, if the
5 accused's license or right to operate a motor vehicle was suspended or revoked by reason of a moving
6 violation or moving violations, such suspension or revocation shall be admissible and deemed relevant
7 to the determination of the question of whether the accused was negligent at the time the offense
8 occurred.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall be known as the Kevin J. Pecor Act.
